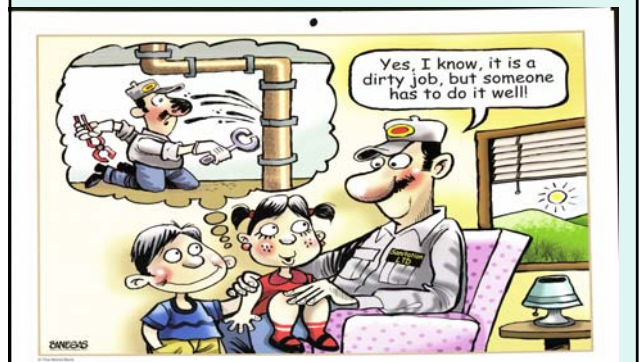

Environmental Issue and Response

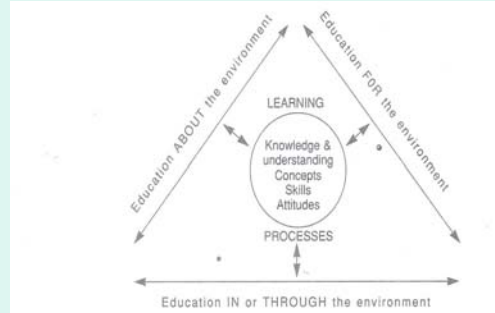
